<u>ORDER</u>

Government have accorded Administrative Sanction for Rs.16 crores for the KRWSA (Jalanidhi) project "Scaling of Rain Water Harvesting and Ground Water Recharging Programme" with a total out lay of Rs.20 crore, limiting the cost of each components to 80% of the original estimate, to be met from the head of account" 2215-01-800-64 (P)".

2. As per Government Order read as 2nd paper above Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.1205 lakhs was accorded to Executive Director, Jalanidhi for implementation of the project, "Sustainability Support to Community Managed Water Supply Schemes", by meeting the expenditure of Rs.1000 lakhs from the budget allocation for 2018-19 under the head of account "2215-01-102 -80" and Rs. 205 lakhs by mobilizing funds from the concerned BG/GP share for the project. 3. In the wake of the devastating floods that ravaged the State, directions have been issued to prioritise and re-plan projects/works to be undertaken in 2018-19, vide Government Order read as 3rd paper above. Accordingly, the Executive Director, Jalanidhi submitted proposal as per the letter read as 4th paper above. Consequent to the flood damages 583 schemes belonging to Jalanidhi Phase I & II together rendering service delivery to nearly 4.3 lakhs rural population could not continue to deliver the service. Hence these schemes were proposed to be restored. The Executive Director, Jalanishi requested to approve the revised scope of the scheme and to issue revised administrative sanction for the scheme for Rs.2150 lakh

4. The total allocation for "Scaling up of Rain Water Harvesting & GWR Schemes" for the current Financial Year is 2000 lakh, out of which Rs.500 lakh was proposed to be re-appropriated towards the restoration of the flood damaged schemes under Jalanidhi Phase-I and II projects. The Executive Director, KRWSA, therefore, proposed to revise the administrative sanction by limiting the amount sanctioned for the project "Sustainability Support to Community Managed Water Supply Schemes", to Rs.15 crore.

5. The proposals were placed before the Special Working Group on 05.11.2018 and the proposals for revised administrative sanction for the said two schemes were approved by the Special Working Group.

6. As per letter read as 6th paper above, the Executive Director Jalanidhi submitted the proposal for re-appropriation and additional authorisation. The existing provision under the head of account "2215-01-102-80" is Rs 1000 lakh only. The additional funds of Rs 1150 lakh over and above the Budget provision has been proposed to be met through the reappropriation of Rs 500 lakh from the head of account "2215-01-800-64 (P) Scaling up of Rain Water Harvesting & GWR schemes through KRWSA" and additional authorization of Rs 650 lakhs.

7. Govt have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order as follows:-

(i) Revised Administative Sanction for Rs 15 Crore only(Rupees Fifteen Crore only) is accorded to the Executive Director, for implementation of "Scaling up of Rain Water Harvesting & Ground Water Schemes" under the head of account "2215-01-800-64(P)"limiting the cost of each of the aforesaid components to 75 % of the original estimate as follows:-
