ORDER

A new scheme under the State Plan was proposed for inclusion in the 13th Five Year Plan (under State Plan)during the period 2018-19 to 2021-22 under the head of account" 2215-01-102-80" in order to extend the sustainability support to Community Managed Water Supply Schemes implemented under Jalanidhi-I & II Projects by appropriate intervention. Accordingly, in 2018-19, Administrative Sanction for Rs.10 crore was accorded for implementation of "Sustainability Support to Community Managed Water Supply Schemes", vide Government Order read as second paper above and Rs 55 crore has been provided in the budget of the current year for the scheme for the revival/restoration of the fully/partially defunct 1100 Nos of water supply schemes implemented under Jalanidhi -I & II Projects, owned and managed by the community, by extending the sustainability support and by appropriate intervention.

2.As per letter read as third paper above Executive Director, Jalanidhi requested to accord sanction for the implementation of Sustainability Support to Community Managed Water Supply Scheme as per the Project Implementation Plan(PIP) of the ongoing Jalanidhi- Phase II(EAP) Project approved vide GO read as 1st paper above.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for adoption of Project Implementation Plan of the Jalanidhi Phase -II Project, approved as per G.O. read as 1st paper above, to implement

the Sustainability Support to Community Managed Water Supply Schemes also and to allow the Governing Body of KRWSA to make minor modifications in the PIP without increasing overall and per capita cost of implementation in the new projects.
